Thank you for your interest in the post of Housing Support Worker at Nottingham Arimathea Trust (NAT).

Nottingham Arimathea Trust is proud to be one of the principle third sector organisations in Nottingham's robust asylum seeker and refugee support network. This post is essential to ensure that our services and reputation are upheld.

The NAT model of working allows:

- asylum seekers who have evidence to support a fresh claim to have a safe home and security while being actively assisted in re-engaging in the asylum process,
- vulnerable refugees with recently granted status to integrate and move on from our supported accommodation into their own tenancies, and to be supported and motivated to access training, volunteering opportunities or employment.

We work in partnership with a wide range of organisations and services to provide holistic, person-centered support to our residents. Our accommodation is temporary supported housing with a mixed portfolio of shared houses, family homes and individual one-bedroom flats.
